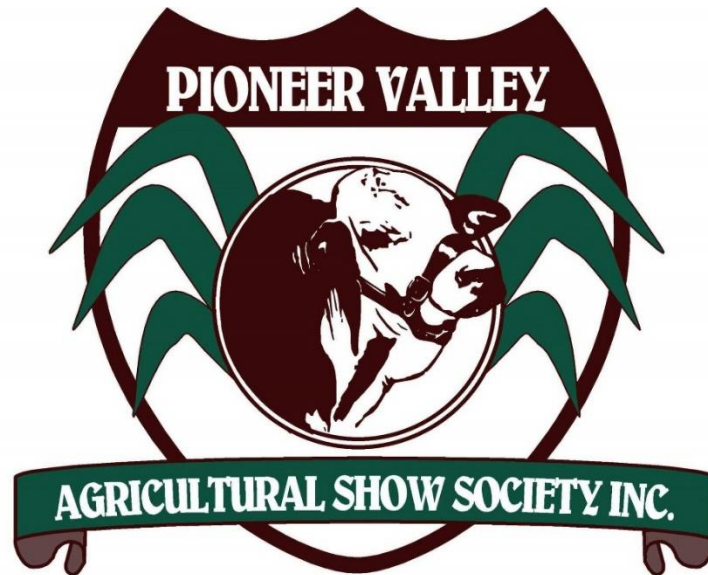

A completed “Record of Attendance at Horse Events” form must be completed by ALL horse competitors and handed in at the Ring Office upon arrival at the showgrounds.

Please ensure your property is registered with the DPI via their website. The DPI will provide you with a registered Property Identification Code (PIC) which is to be written on your *Record of Attendance at Horse Events* form.

ENTRY FEES: Show Jump Events As per schedule .

PRIZE MONEY: Led, Breed & Rider Classes 1st - \$20 2nd - \$15 3rd - \$10
Hack Classes 1st - \$25 2nd - \$15 3rd - \$10

Nominations and Prize Money for SHOWJUMPING as per program.

Prize money in any classes may be reduced at the discretion of the Steward, where it is deemed there are insufficient competitors.

Less than 5 competitors – no 3rd prize money

Less than 3 competitors – no 2nd prize money

Events and Sponsors are current at time of publishing. However, they may be subject to change on Show Day should the need arise.

ENTRY TO THE GROUNDS:

Prepaid entry passes are available purchase on our website: www.pioneervalleyshow.com.au

PARKING: All vehicles including horse floats and trailers must enter through the Western entrance situated on Eungella side of Showground. Please allow extra time for possible traffic delays through the gate. Horse floats and trailers to park in designated area only. **Please check with traffic controller prior to parking your vehicle.**

STABLING: A limited number of stables are available. They will be charged out at \$10 (covered) or \$5 (open) per stable per night. There will also be a compulsory cleaning fee of \$20 per stable. Contact the Show Secretary on 49583162 or email secretary@pioneervalleyshow.com.au to make a booking.

CAMPING: \$30 per camp site per night. No pre booking required BUT **camping permit must be displayed on dash – can be collected from show office or ring office (when open) directions of the grounds man or parking/camping steward must be strictly adhered to.**

FENCING: Electric fences must measure no more than 4m x 4m and run side-by-side along the side of the vehicle from the day prior to the show – Friday 13th June

PIONEER VALLEY SHOW SOCIETY REGULATIONS

1. The age of a Horse shall be calculated from August 1st, in any year and shall be deemed 1 year old.
2. Horses must be free from hereditary unsoundness in all classes. Horses to be paraded on the day, at the times directed by the Steward.
3. HELMETS must be used by all riders whilst on the Showground to comply with the EA Standard (AS/NZ 3838:1998 or EN 1384 or ASTIN F1163)
4. Competitors, Exhibitors, Grooms or Others in charge of exhibits, must obey the Stewards or they shall be removed from the grounds.
5. All Horses measuring out of classes will be transferred to correct classes.
6. Pony Hacks must not exceed 14hh and may be ridden by children or adults.
7. Galloway Hacks shall be over 14hh and not exceeding 15hh and cannot compete in other Hack Classes unless otherwise directed.
8. Stallions are not permitted in Hack Classes, with the exception of ARAB and ASH Hack Classes.
9. ALL STALLIONS may compete in Show Jumping Classes.
10. ALL STALLIONS are to properly supervised at ALL TIMES whilst on the ground.
11. ALL STALLIONS in HALTER CLASSES to be in a bit or BAR AND CHAIN.
12. MAIDEN shall mean the entry has never won a championship in a similar event at the time of starting.
13. NOVICE shall mean that the entry has never won a championship in a similar event at the time of starting.
14. LOCAL RIDER is a rider permanently residing within 50km radius of Finch Hatton.
15. NO RING shall be required to wait for a Competitor who is competing in another Ring.
16. A HORSE ENTRY/PLACE CARD system will be used. Cards will be handed, fully completed to the Ring Steward prior to competing in the class. Place getters eligible for prize money, will receive their prize money at the conclusion of the class, together with their ribbons. Their cards will be signed by the judge but retained by their steward for Show Society records.
17. ENTRY FEES WILL NOT BE REFUNDED WHERE THE EVENT IS HELD AND THE COMPETITOR FAILS TO PARTICIPATE.
18. The Ring Committee reserves the right to substitute trophies in lieu of cash prizes.
19. The Ring Committee reserves the right to alter the schedule and program if deemed necessary.
20. PROTESTS must be lodged in writing with the Secretary, accompanied by a \$50 fee, within 30 minutes of the notification of the Judge's award. If the protest is deemed frivolous, the fee shall be forfeited.
21. The Show Society may carry out random Drug testing.
22. Due to WORK PLACE HEALTH AND SAFETY, no livestock can be treated for ticks on the Showground. All return treatments will be carried out at the tick line. It is the responsibility of anyone travelling stock to a tick free areas to make their arrangements with inspectors at these centres.

DISCLAIMER After the purchase of nomination tickets competitors agree to abide by society rules and compete at their own risk. Neither the organizing committee or persons involved in the running of the competition Saturday 13th June and Sunday 14th June, 2026, shall be held responsible for the loss, damage or injury to any person, animal or property whatsoever whilst on the Pioneer Valley Showground.

Lighting of Fires on Showgrounds is strictly prohibited

Patrons & participants who observe emergencies or accidents that occur on the show grounds during the period of the show, shall report them immediately to the Show Society Office.

Where animals are being lead, worked & displayed it is the responsibility of the owner or handler at the time, to ensure the animal does not become a public liability.

All animals must be contained in an enclosure or otherwise effectively tethered or harnessed.

Where animals are liable to kick or bite, it is the responsibility of the owner or handler, to ensure public safety.

Please check with ground stewards before parking horse & cattle floats.

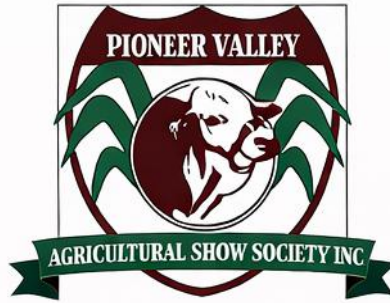
